

**MINUTES**  
**LAW LIBRARY ADVISORS' MEETING**  
**February 11, 2026**

Pursuant to notice duly given, the James J. Lunsford Law Library Advisors (“Advisors”) met on Wednesday, February 11, 2026, at 12:00 p.m. in the Norma J. Wise Room at the Law Library 701 E. Review and approve the Minutes of the Law Library Advisors’ Meeting dated May 20, 2025

- b. It was mentioned that the CLE offerings are changing as the Library System can no longer purchase new CLE titles and can only offer the free Survey of Florida Law title that the Florida Bar provides.

The Law Advisors were informed that the Clerk of Court was needing space to expand court services, so the Law Library Collection was being moved to the John F. Germany Library in March 2026. The entire collection will move, and the collection will be housed on the second floor. Library Regional Manager assured them that space would look nice for customers and keep the integrity of the collection. Ms. Rehbaum offered to provide a tour of the new location at the May meeting.
