

# Relationship Chart

Use this chart to determine the relationship between any two people in a family when a common ancestor is known.

1. Identify the common ancestor of the two people. Locate the box in the upper left corner labeled common ancestor.
2. Find the relationship of the first person to the common ancestor across the top row of the chart.
3. Find the relationship of the second person to the common ancestor down the left column.
4. The point where the rows of these two ancestors intersect indicates their relationship to each other.
